What: A 6,500-square-foot child-care center for children as young as 6 weeks.

When: Expected to open July 2004.

Where: 5089 208th St., on a 2 1/2-acre lot in the Farmington Industrial Park at 208th St. and Eton Av.

Who: The owner and operator of the business is Farmington resident Jan Karrmann.

How much: The construction cost is \$605,000, according to a building permit on file with the city of Farmington.

Details: The new building is designed to be used for day-care, with a playground and with a kitchen to prepare meals for children. Karrmann expects to hire as many as 14 full- or part-time employees. The business will have a before-and after-school program for school-age children.
